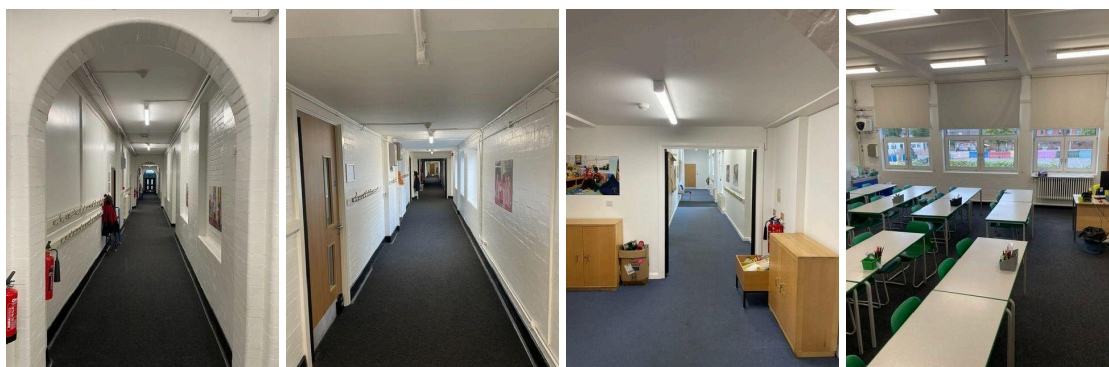
SCHOOL UPDATE: FRIDAY 4 SEPTEMBER 2026

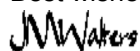
