In-Year appeals will be heard within 30 school days of being lodged.

Notice of Appeal Hearings

The Clerk to the Independent Appeals Panel will write to parents/carers with the date, time and location of the appeal. You will receive at least 10 school days' notice.

Notice of appeal outcomes will be sent within five school days of the hearing wherever possible.

Please note appeal hearings do not take place during school holidays.
