

## Pupil Premium

Pupil Premium is paid to the school to support children from low income families. This includes free school meals for children not entitled to free school meals through Universal Free School Meals provided to children in Reception Year 1 and Year 2. Additional money can be used in a variety of ways to support children both during school hours and after school. Families on Pupil Premium can be financially supported to access Breakfast Club, Late Club, School trips, school uniform and school activities. During the school day Pupil Premium money can be spent on additional classroom support and resources.

If your joint family income is less than £16,190 a year and you are in receipt of any benefits listed below, please complete the form and hand in to the school office.

- Income Support.
- Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance.
- Child Tax Credit – Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and working Tax Credit is not in payment.
- Guarantee Pension Credit.
- Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
