



Attendance

Our attendance target this year is 95.5% and our current figure is 94%.

Good attendance is the starting point of your children's success at school. Unless they are unwell or there is another good reason for them not being able to attend, children should be in school. Even a 90% attendance figure is equivalent to being absent one half-day every week or four whole weeks in a school year. In their time from Reception to Year 6, children with 90% attendance will have missed the equivalent of about a half of a school year.

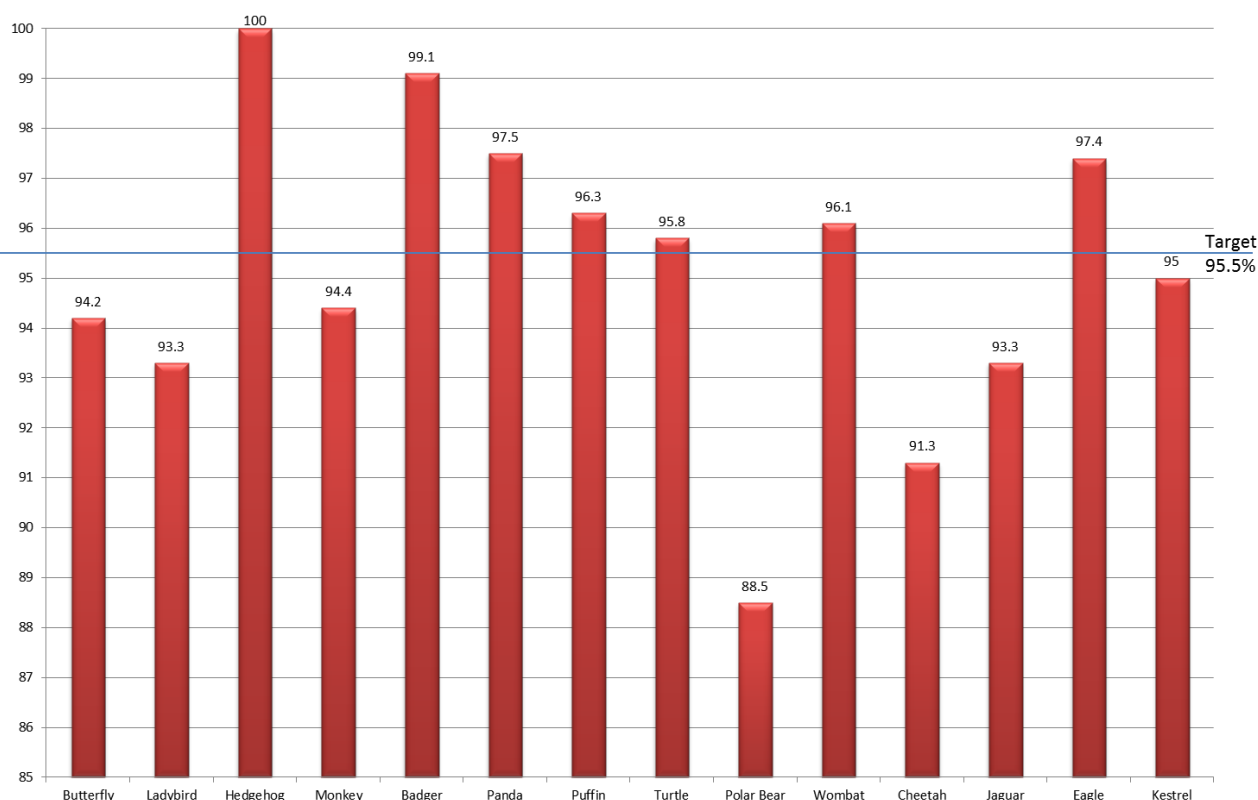

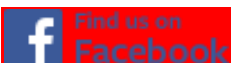
