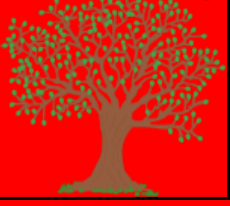

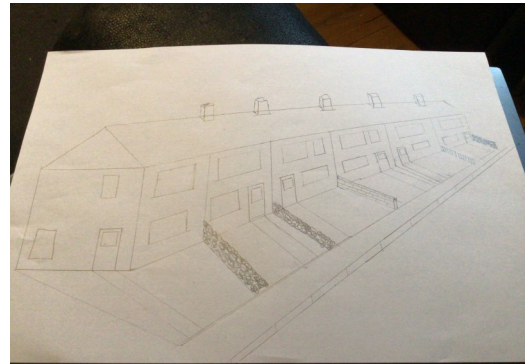

Well done Callum.

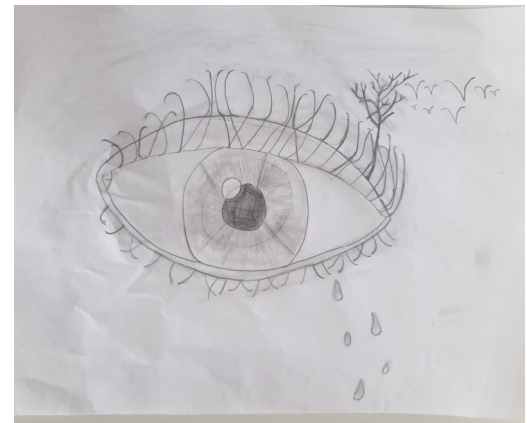

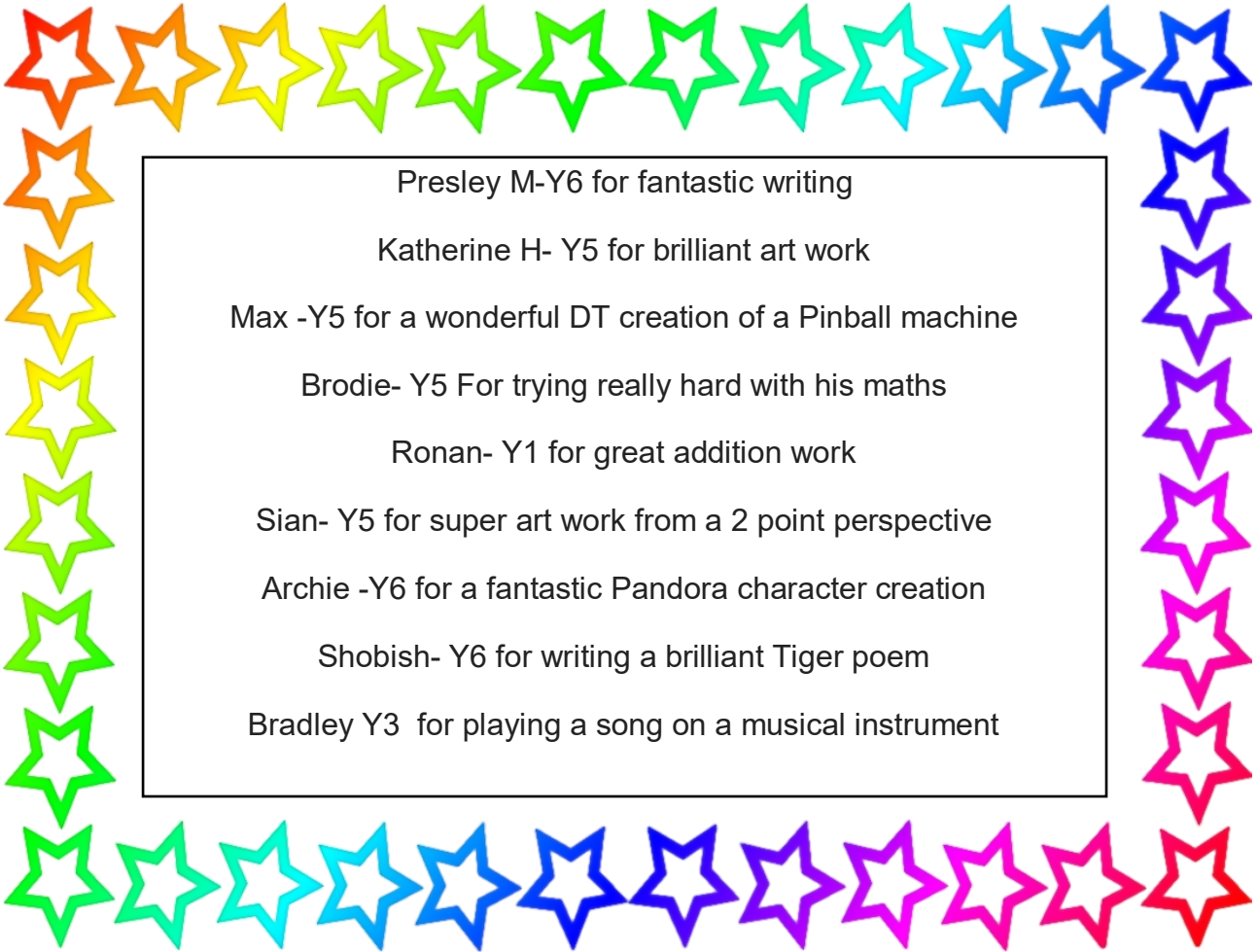
