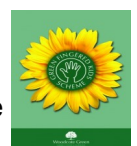

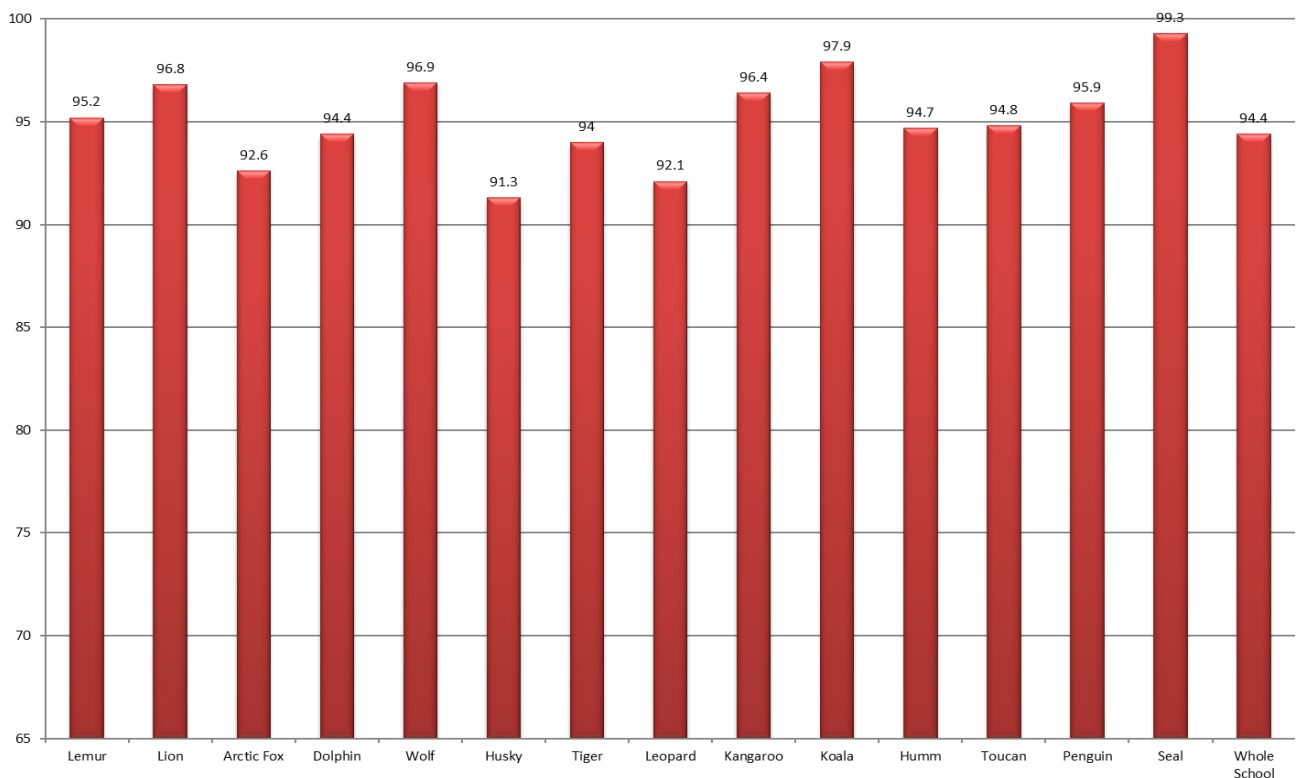
Woodcote Green
