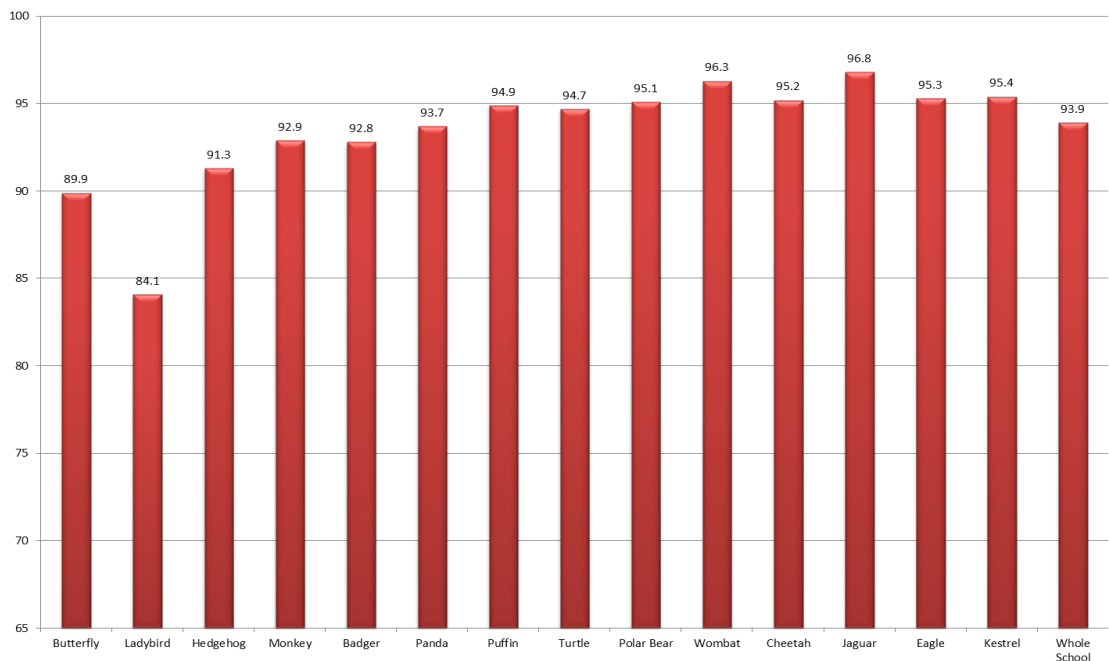
School Bags and equipment
