Reporting Absence

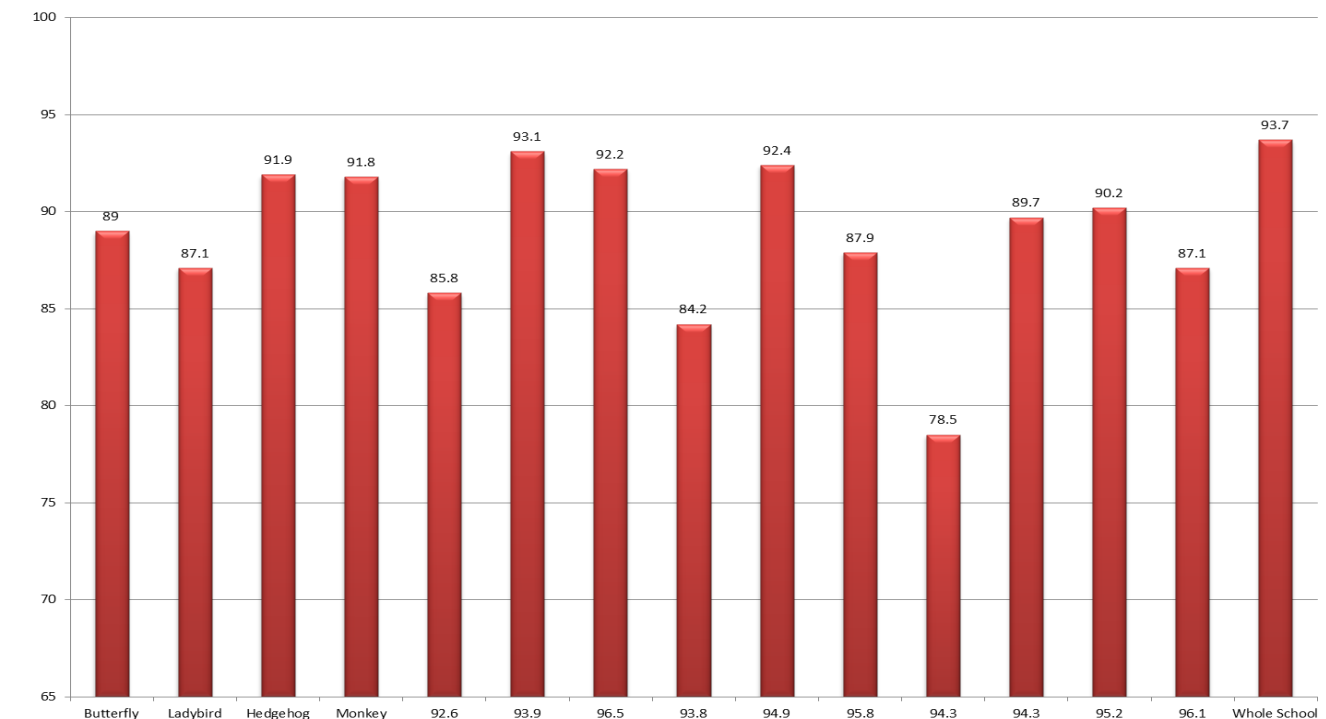
If your child is going to be absent from school, could you please contact the school office by 9.30am to report the reason why.
