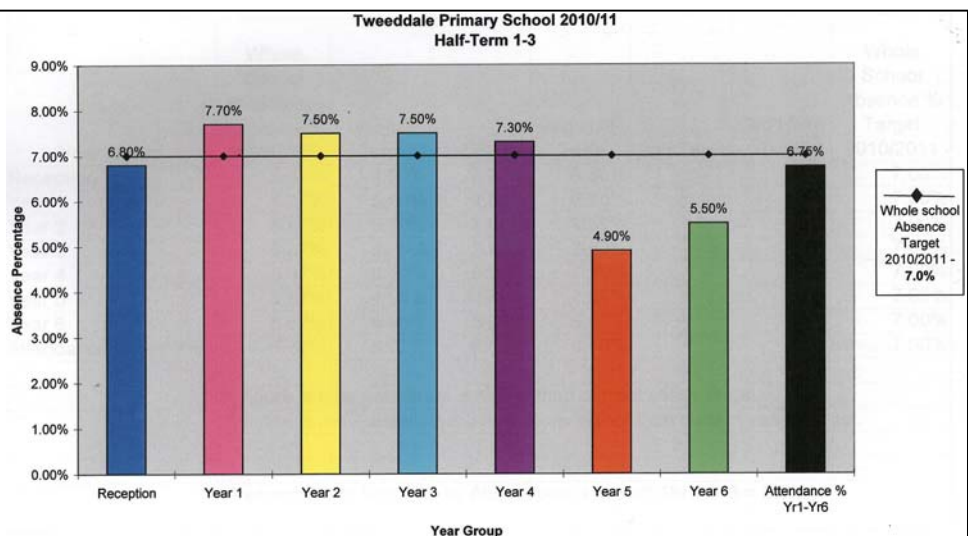


Dear Parents & Carers
