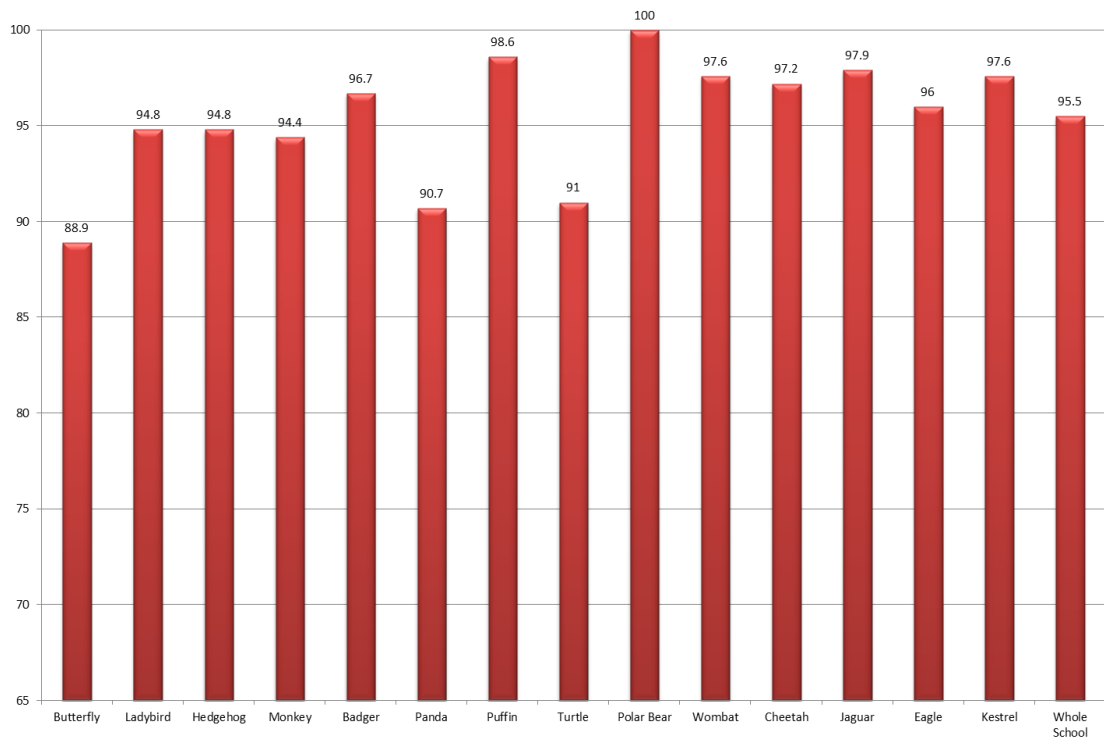
Last day for Class Photo ordering is Tuesday 7th May 2019. Please make sure the photos are back, sealed with the reference number and correct money in the envelope provided.
