Welcome back—well done everyone who got their children in to school yesterday and didn't think it was an inset day.

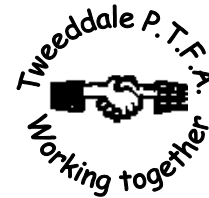
