If we do need to have real lockdown, we will let you know through Groupcall, if possible. If you receive a lockdown message, please do not telephone or come to the school, as this will hamper the work of the emergency services, who will have been called by the school.

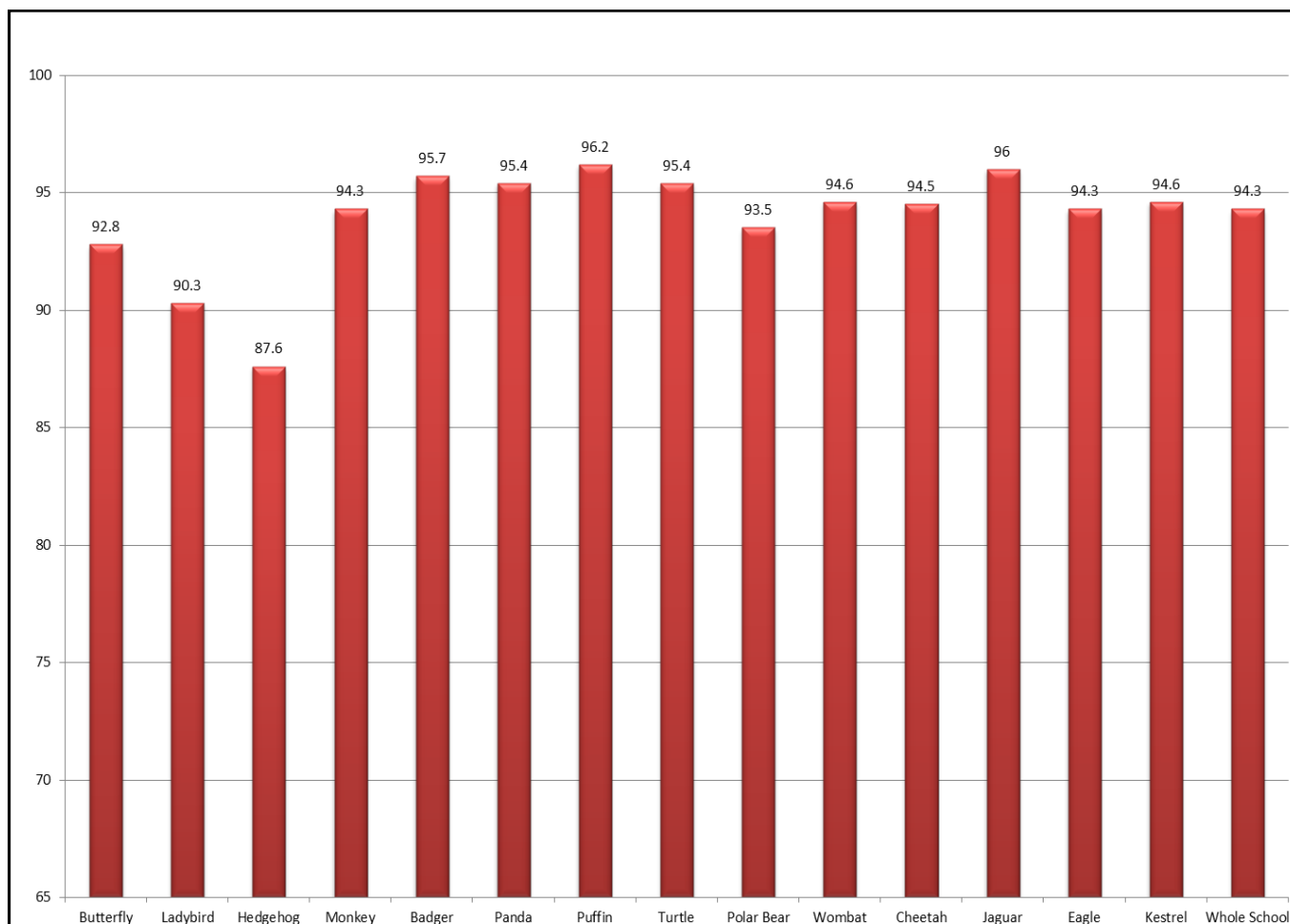
