What to do if your child develops symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19)

Just a reminder as the letter stated on Monday 18th October;

If your child develops symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19), they should get a PCR test and remain at home at least until the result is known.

If negative, the child can end self isolation. If positive the NHS Track and Trace will advise you on the time you need to isolate.

Symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are;

- ◆ A new continuous cough
- ◆ High Temperature
- ◆ A loss of, or change in their normal sense of smell (anosmia)
