

Dear Parents/Carers,

Further to the email we sent out earlier in the week relating to parents parking illegally on the school zig-zag markings, we would like to update you on the current situation.

We take the ongoing situation of road safety very seriously and had hoped that the zig-zag lines would remedy this. It has proven not to be the case (although it remains a small minority who are choosing to ignore the clear rules surrounding this).

As you may have seen earlier in the week, we have contacted the police to make them aware of the situation. However even this didn't seem to resolve the situation as on the next occasion they were not there, parents began parking/dropping-off on the zig-zags.

We have therefore escalated our efforts in making the council aware of the huge safety implications to our children around the illegal parking on Tweeddale Road.

As a school, we have contacted the Highways and Transport team (both road engineering and parking enforcement) as well as Elliot Colburn MP.

We would just like to reassure you that as a school, we are doing everything within our power to resolve this extremely worrying issue.

We are very grateful for the support we have received from the majority of parents who do not park/drop-off on the zig-zag markings.

Please do not be offended when you are asked to move from the zig-zag markings; it is for the safety and well-being of all the community.
